Travel clinics are not publicly funded in Nova Scotia. The International Travel clinic is a service provided by Public Health, Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA) and operates the clinic on a cost recovery basis. Prices are reviewed periodically to reflect changes in vaccine and administration costs.

Please note there is a charge for missed appointments unless 24 hours notice is given. This is necessary because of the high number of clients who do not show for their appointments.

There is a \$10.00 charge to provide copies of immunization records by fax or mail. Prior payment is required before this information is released.
