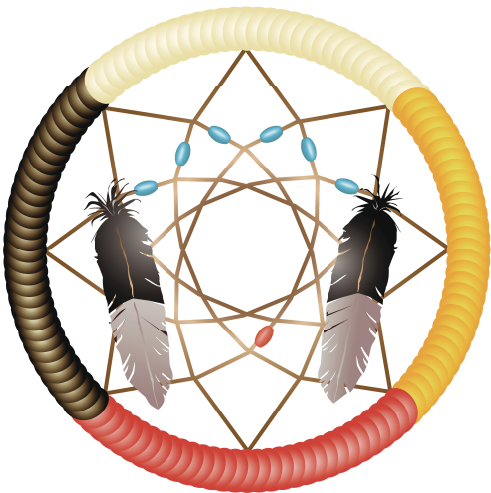

**We can help you:**

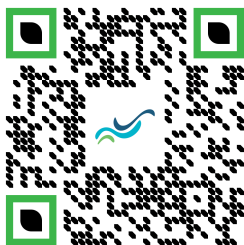
- Talk with your health care providers
