Nurse Practitioner Clinic

Primary healthcare clinic with a team that includes a Nurse Practitioner, Family Practice Nurse and Pharmacist

This service is for patients aged 18+ who:

- 1. Do not have a primary healthcare provider
- 2. Have a primary care provider but are unable to get a same-day appointment.

We treat non-urgent health concerns, like:

- Prescription refills or renewals
- Minor respiratory symptoms
- Sore throat, Earaches
- Fever, Headache
- Rashes
- Minor gastrointestinal concerns (vomiting and diarrhea)
- Cough, flu or cold symptoms
- Urinary Tract infections
- Muscle pain
- Minor pelvic or abdominal pain
- Blood pressure control
- Smoking cessation


These clinics *do not* offer refills or new prescriptions for controlled drugs/substances.
