

## Pharmacist/Nursing Drop-In

Primary healthcare clinic with a team that includes a Pharmacist and Family Practice Nurse



### We assess and treat non-urgent health concerns, such as:

- Cold sores, impetigo, swimmer's ear, plantar warts, pink eye
- Mild nausea, headache and pain lasting < 2 weeks
- Pinworms, oral thrush, insomnia, mild acne
- Yeast infections
- Prescription renewals

### We assess and help manage chronic conditions, such as:

- COPD
- Diabetes
- High blood pressure/high cholesterol
- Weight management

### We can assess and, in some cases, prescribe for concerns, such as:

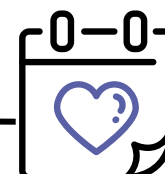
- Urinary tract infections (in females age 16+ ,with some exclusions)
- Birth control
- Tick bites/Lyme disease prophylaxis
- Shingles

## Virtual Urgent Care



Consult with a physician virtually via a tablet, with in-person assessment and follow-up from nurses and staff. Available during some clinics.

### Your appointment



When you arrive, please have:

- Your provincial health (MSI) card
- A list of your medications / pharmacy name

We will ask you the reason for your visit to make sure we can treat your health concern.

If we can treat your health concern, our Family Practice Nurse or Pharmacist will collect essential vitals, and see you within order of arrival.
