

What information is available in my online health records and when will it be available to me?



This document explains the types of health records available in YourHealthNS, the information included, and the date range for each record. It is regularly updated to ensure the details remain current and easy to understand.

Glossary
<p>Records: This is used to describe all health records, including information about your medications, hospital visits and stays, health visits and immunizations. It also refers to the information about the appointments you had for diagnostic imaging tests.</p> <p>Results: This refers to the information from your diagnostic imaging, blood, urine, and general lab tests. Lab and diagnostic imaging results may include what we would think of as the result of the test, such as “Immune” or “Positive”, or they may only contain general information such as the ordering provider, lab location, and result date and time.</p> <p>Reports: These are more detailed records that include the clinician’s interpretation of the diagnostic imaging test. We now offer reports for X-rays, Ultrasounds, Mammogram, MRI, and CT and PET scan.</p>
