



Cape Breton Regional Hospital

Cape Breton Regional Hospital is the regional referral and trauma centre for Cape Breton Island. It is also part of a four-hospital complex that includes Glace Bay Hospital, New Waterford Consolidated Hospital and Northside General. These four sites are part of the Cape Breton Regional Municipality Health Care Redevelopment Project, a multi-year, phased project to redesign and rebuild health care infrastructure with a focus on innovation to support patients and families, health care teams, physicians and researchers now and into the future.

The project at Cape Breton Regional Hospital includes a new Cape Breton Cancer Centre and a clinical services building that will house an emergency department, critical care department, inpatient beds, surgical suites, and maternal/newborn services.

Located in Sydney, Nova Scotia, Cape Breton Regional Hospital has more than 150 physicians, and approximately 3,000 staff.
