



Fishermen's Memorial Hospital

Fishermen's Memorial Hospital is located in Lunenburg, on the south shore of Nova Scotia. While the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg has a population of 25,545 people, this number swells during the tourist season with a large number of visitors and seasonal residents in the Town of Lunenburg and nearby communities such as Mahone Bay and Chester.

Fishermen's Memorial Hospital has 46 medical inpatient beds. Approximately 309 employees provide the following programs and services:

Veteran's Unit

The Veteran's Unit at Fishermen's Memorial Hospital is a 16-bed unit offering a team approach to care that includes physiotherapy, occupational therapy, recreation, music, and other supports focused on enriching the quality of life for the veterans.
