Nutrition Education and Counselling

Registered dietitians offer nutrition services across western Nova Scotia (Annapolis Valley, South Shore, and Southwest Nova Scotia).

These services include:

- **Medical nutrition therapy:**
 - › This includes nutrition information and advice to prevent, treat, or manage health conditions. Medical nutrition therapy can be with only you and your dietitian, or in a group.
 - › This is a free service covered by Nova Scotia's provincial health insurance program (MSI). You must bring your provincial health card with you to each appointment.

• **Education on:**

- › High blood pressure (also called **hypertension**)
- › High cholesterol
- › Food allergies and intolerances
- › Gastrointestinal (digestive system) problems
- › Eating disorders and disordered eating

- › Prenatal (pregnancy) and pediatric (child) nutrition
- › Other nutrition-related concerns

How do I make an appointment with a dietitian?

- **You can be referred by:**
 - › Your primary health care provider (family doctor or nurse practitioner)
 - › Other health care providers (like a nurse, a physiotherapist, a social worker, or a psychologist)
 - › Yourself
