It is very important that you drink all your liquid bowel preparation for your safety and for the procedure to work properly. You must complete the following bowel preparation:
For 4 days before your procedure (starting on),
take 2 Senokot® tablets in the morning and 2 Senokot® tablets at supper.
Starting on, take PegLyte®, 2 Tbsp in 1 cup of water, 8 times each day (for a total of 2 litres each day), or until your bowel movements are liquid.

 Wear comfortable, loose-fitting clothing. Sweatpants are a good choice.
• Do not wear a belt.
DO NOT take any medications unless told otherwise by your doctor.
• DO NOT eat or drink anything after: (time).
 If you have diabetes, you may have clear fluids (like water or clear juice). If you take insulin, follow your doctor's instructions for taking it on the day of your procedure.
 Bring all of your medications with you in their original containers.
