QEII Cancer Care Program (Halifax)

Are there special parking rates for cancer patients?

Outpatients of the cancer care program can get reduced rate parking vouchers (50% off) for hospital parking. When you register for a cancer clinic or chemotherapy appointment you can receive a voucher. Also, if you are going to have 14 or more radiation treatments, you will be given a form by the radiation registration clerks to take to the parking services office to receive enough passes for the duration of your treatment.

If you are an inpatient you can ask the unit clerk for parking vouchers which are available to patients on the unit .

How much does it cost to park in the VG site lots?

The parking rates for the VG site lots are listed below. Rates are charged per 1/2 hour or part thereof:

\$3.00 first hour \$3.00 second hour \$2.50 each additional hour \$14.50 Daily Maximum \$4.00 Maximum on weekends
