

Queens General Hospital

Queens General Hospital is located in Liverpool, on the south shore of Nova Scotia, and serves a population of approximately 10,422 in the Region of Queens Municipality.

The hospital has 22 inpatient beds with a medical unit and a procedure unit. Approximately 150 employees provide the following programs and services:
