Valley Regional Hospital, which opened in 1992, serves the people of Kings and Annapolis Counties, and provides specialty services as a referral centre for the Annapolis Valley and other areas of Western Nova Scotia. Valley Regional Hospital, located in Kentville, Nova Scotia, is one of three regionals in the Western Zone and has approximately 1143 active employees. The Western Zone’s orthopedics and vascular program is based here.
