What is the Adult Day Clinic?

- The Adult Day Clinic offers a range of health care and support services. Our goals are to:
 - › Help you stay in your home safely and independently for as long as possible
 - › Improve your quality of life
 - › Help your support person(s) make daily responsibilities more manageable
- Most people come to the clinic once every 1 or 2 weeks. Talk with clinic staff about what is right for you.

Who is the clinic for?

- The clinic is for adults (18 years old or older) who:
 - › Have a cognitive (thinking) or physical condition
 - › Need more than 1 of the services offered by the clinic
 - › Feel alone or lonely
 - › Want to socialize (talk, do activities, or spend time with other people)

- It is also for people who are caring for a loved one and:
 - › Need support
 - › Need help managing their own health, well-being, or personal care

What services does the clinic offer?

- › Foot care
 - › Dressings for injuries or ulcers
 - › A tub bath or a shower
 - › Answering questions you may have about your health
 - › Medication review
 - › Helping you arrange home care
 - › Recreation (like socials, cards, games, and other activities)
- We can also book appointments like:
 - › Blood work or other tests
 - › Physiotherapy
 - › Occupational therapy
 - › A social worker
 - › A dietitian

What will happen when I come to the clinic?

- Please come to the clinic by 10 a.m.
- While you are at the clinic, you may:
 - › Have coffee and muffins with clinic staff and visitors
 - › Have a tub bath, a shower, or other personal care, as needed
 - › Have your vital signs (like your temperature, blood pressure, heart rate, pulse, and breathing) checked. This will be done at every visit.
 - › Have lunch and a dessert
 - › Have a treat (like ice cream)
 - › Socialize, play cards or games, and do other activities
 - › Access other services, as needed
