Those selected will have the following qualifications:

- Recent personal or family/caregiver experience at a primary health care family practice, clinic, or program (ie. Diabetes Education Centre)
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Can look at issues from more than one point of view
- Can share honest points of view in a respectful way
- Be reflective of diverse populations and perspectives in our community
- Interested in making a positive contribution to health care services
- Previous volunteer experience is an asset.

Additional requirements:

- Sign a confidentiality agreement
- Have or be willing to obtain a Criminal Background Check
- Declare any potential conflicts of interest
- Be able to commit to attend virtual or location specific meetings within the Cumberland County, typically held during the day.
