- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Can look at issues from more than one point of view.
- Can share honest points of view in a respectful way.
- Be reflective of diverse populations and perspectives in our community.
- Interested in making a positive contribution to health care services.
- Previous volunteer experience is an asset.

Additional requirements:

- Sign a confidentiality agreement.
- Have or be willing to obtain a Criminal Background Check.
- Declare any potential conflicts of interest.
- Be able to commit to attend at least four meetings per year. Meetings are typically held every fourth Tuesday of each month from 2:30pm until 4pm, at the Cape Breton Regional Hospital and via Microsoft Teams.
- Be able to commit to a term of two (2) years.
